

Following the CMAS Board of Directors' decision (BoD 172 from 18/02/2011) approved by the CMAS General Assembly 21/05/2011 :

a) Allow using on any competitions organized with CMAS rules in swimming pools only CMAS homologated competitive swimsuits which have CMAS logos. In addition, allow using freely (as the alternative to these swimsuits) swim briefs/bathing short trunks and classical one-piece swimsuits/normal swimsuits or two pieces normal swimsuit of any manufacturers.

b) Homologate for the period 2012-2015 competitive swimsuits – Diana (models: DIANA CMAS M1-DIANA CMAS M2-DIANA CMAS W1) and Aquarapid (models: Aquarapid CMAS M1 - Aquarapid CMAS M2 - Aquarapid CMAS W1) only legskin and bodyskin types.

c) Approve p. 2.3.3.5 CMAS Finswimming Rules in the following version:

2.3.3.5. The swimmers must appear in decent sports wear : for men bathing short trunks (fig. 6);

for women – normal swimsuits (fig. 7) or two pieces normal swimsuit (fig. 8). Allow using competitive swimsuits (full body or legs (fig. 9)) only homologated by CMAS and with proper logos. All bathing clothes must not have an effect on the natural buoyancy of the swimmers. Only one swimsuit is allowed. A swimming- cap is authorized.

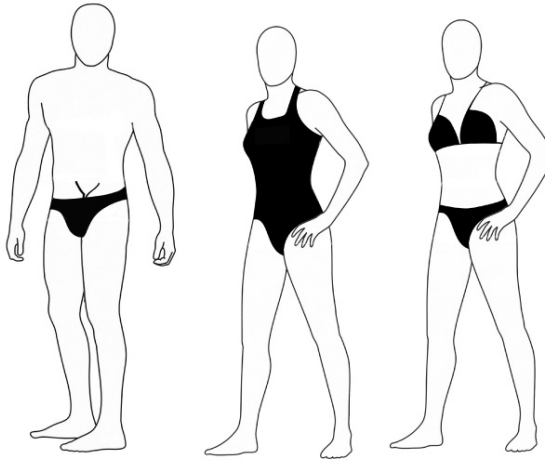

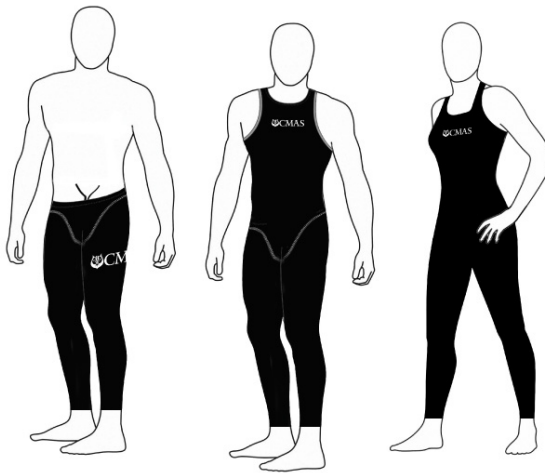
